

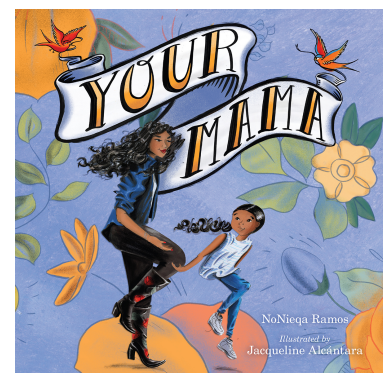
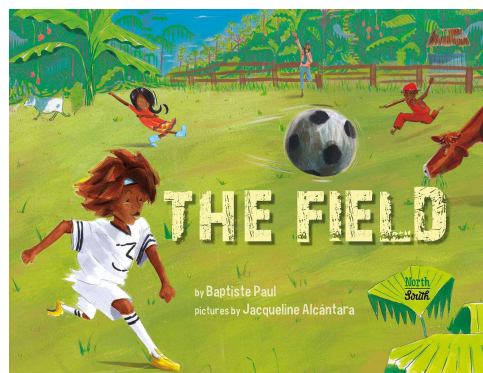
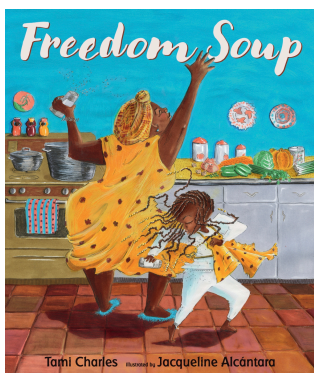

She's collected **14 starred reviews** thus far, ALL books receiving a Kirkus starred review! She was a **high school art teacher** before transitioning to illustration and loves the opportunity to get back into schools to share her enthusiasm for books, art and illustration. She was the inaugural winner of the "We Need Diverse Books" illustrator Mentorships and strives to promote diversity in publishing.

In addition to working with top editors/ publishers in publishing, she has worked with clients such as Obama foundation, NPR, The Chicago Reader, The Southern Poverty Law Center, and University of Chicago, creating illustrations for a range of editorial projects. She's also an **adjunct professor** at Columbia College Chicago teaching illustration.
